How to get there

By plane

The closest airport is Václav Havel Airport Praha

Airport transport (taxi / shuttle) is available for approximately 11 Euro.

There are also bus stops at the Václav Havel Airport Praha and two possibilities

1. take the bus (special airport line) to the stop Hlavní nádraží (main train station) > then cross to the metro (line C) and > go to the stop Roztyly (direction Háje)
2. take the bus no. 119 and go to the stop Nádraží Veleslavín > then take the metro and go to the stop Muzeum (line A, direction Depo Hostivař) > in Muzeum cross to the metro line C and > go to the stop Roztyly (direction Háje)

One-way bus tickets are available for 32 CZK (approximately 1,20 Euro).

By train

Participants coming by train should arrive at the main train station ‘Hlavní Nádraží’ and then take the metro (line C, direction Háje) > go to the stop Roztyly.

One-way metro tickets are available for 32 CZK (approximately 1,20 Euro).
